### **a. New Policy on Broadening the Pathways for Further Studies (Applicable to S1 to S4 students)**

Ever since the implementation of the New Academic Structure in September 2009, the school has provided a broad and balanced curriculum for senior forms, which allows students with different abilities, interests and aptitudes to develop their potentials. In addition to compulsory subjects, Applied Learning is also one of the elective subjects. Applied Learning offers studies with equal emphasis on practice and theory linked to broad professional and vocational fields. It aims to enable students to understand fundamental theories and concepts, and helps students explore their career aspirations and orientation of life-long learning.

All assessments of the Applied Learning courses (HKDSE Category B subjects) are undertaken by respective course providers based on students' performance during the courses. There is no public examination. The reporting of students' performance is refined to 'Attained', 'Attained with Distinction (I)' and 'Attained with Distinction (II)'. Performance of 'Attained with Distinction (I)' is comparable to Level 3 while 'Attained with Distinction (II)' is comparable to Level 4 or above of the Category A subjects of the HKDSE.

Tertiary institutions in general value the learning experiences of students acquired in Applied Learning. Applied Learning subjects are used as elective subjects, or considered for award of extra bonus or additional information, varying by individual institutions, faculties, or programmes. Therefore, taking Applied Learning courses can provide students with a wider variety of options.

In view of this, the school is introducing the following policies in the new academic year to promote multiple pathways for further studies:

#### **1. Secondary 3 students**

The students who are ranked the last 40 in the Half-yearly Examination should apply for an Applied Learning course with teachers' guidance, and proceed with the Applied Learning course admitted in Secondary 4.

After the S4 Yearly Examination, students will be provided with a projection grade in each subject of HKDSE. If the projection grade of any elective subjects is Level 1 or below, the students must drop the elective subject concerned and focus on the rest of the subjects.

#### **2. Secondary 4 students**

After the Half-yearly Examination, students will be provided with a projection grade in each subject of HKDSE. If the projection grade of any of the elective subjects is Level 1 or below, the students have to apply for an Applied Learning course with teacher's guidance.

After the Yearly Examination, if the projection grade of any of the elective subjects is still Level 1 or below, the students must drop the elective subject concerned and proceed with the Applied Learning Course admitted.

Applied Learning offers diversified courses which do not only broaden the horizons of students, but also allow students with different abilities and interests to develop their potentials and advance to their favorite tertiary institutions. ### **b. New Arrangements of Swimming Gala and SA AGM**

Due to the Covid-19 situation, the Swimming Gala which was initially scheduled on 5.10.2020 (Monday) will be postponed until further notice. Students will have lessons according to the Tuesday timetable on 5.10.2020 (Monday).

The SA AGM which was initially scheduled on 18.9.2020 (Friday) will be deferred to 16.10.2020 (Friday). On that day, potential cabinets of the Student Association Election will present their proposals in the third period, followed by students voting in the fourth period. The Joint Inauguration of Student Leaders will be rescheduled to 23.10.2020 (Friday).

### **c. Face-to-face Class Resumption for S6 on 16.9.2020 (Wednesday)**

Our school facilities have been used during Universal Community Testing (UCTP) until 7.9.2020 (Monday). The Government has conducted thorough cleaning and disinfection of the sites after the completion of UCTP to ensure the hygiene and health of the school premises.

According to the instructions of Education Bureau, our school would resume face-to-face classes in two phases: 23.9.2020 (Wednesday) for S1, S5 and S6 classes while 29.9.2020 (Tuesday) for S2, S3 and S4 classes. To better prepare for public examinations, our school would arrange S6 students to return to campus for classes on 16.9.2020 (Wednesday).

### **d. Temporary Closure of Tuck-shop**

To avoid crowd gathering, tuck-shop would not open until further notice. Students should bring their own snacks. Students are reminded to maintain good personal hygiene and maintain an appropriate social distance.

## a. 擴闊升學出路新政策（適用於中一至中四學生）

自二零零九年九月推行新學制開始，學校所提供寬廣而均衡的高中課程皆能讓不同能力、興趣和性向的學生盡展所長。除了必修科目外，應用學習亦為選修科目之一，其課程兼具實踐與理論，學生不但可從課程中學習相關內容和概念，更能探索自己的事業抱負和終身學習方向。

於成績匯報方面，應用學習課程屬於香港中學文憑考試乙類科目，不設公開考試，成績以同學於修讀期間的課業作評估。當中成績細分為：「達標」、「達標並表現優異(I)」和「達標並表現優異(II)」三項。考獲「達標並表現優異(I)」等同香港中學文憑考試第三級的成績，而「達標並表現優異(II)」的更等同第四級或以上的成績。

香港各大專院校均認可同學在應用學習所累積的學習經驗，個別院校、學院或課程亦承認應用學習科目作為入學所要求的選修科目、甚至給予額外分數或作為額外輔助資料，故此修讀應用學習課程更可為同學提供多元化的出路選擇。

有見及此，校方將於新學年引入以下政策，讓同學有更多元化的升學出路：

### 一、應屆中三學生

於半年試總平均分排名為全級最後四十名的同學，經老師指導下需先報讀應用學習課程，並於升讀中四時修讀已獲取錄的科目。

中四年終試結束後，校方除發出成績表外，更將以統計方法為同學提供各科於香港中學文憑考試的預期成績，假如任何一個選修科目的預期成績為一級或以下，同學需退修有關選修科目，以便全力應付其他科目。

### 二、應屆中四學生

半年試結束後，校方除發出成績表外，更將以統計方法為同學提供各科於香港中學文憑考試的預期成績，假如任何一個選修科目的預期成績為一級或以下，同學經老師指導下需報讀應用學習課程。

年終試結束後，校方亦會為同學提供各科於香港中學文憑考試的預期成績，假如任何一個選修科目的預期成績為一級或以下，同學需退修有關選修科目，以便全力應付其他科目，並得以修讀獲取錄的應用學習課程。
